**WITHDRAWAL ORDER**

WHEREAS, permission was granted to **NATIONAL B.Ed. COLLEGE, 7/68, CIVIL LINES, SIRMOUR CHOWK, REWA 486001, MADHYA PRADESH** under section 15 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting M.Ed course vide order dated 27.09.2006 for an annual intake of 40 seats.

AND WHEREAS, Letter dated 30.10.2013 was issued to the institution informing that the said institution does not fulfill the provisions as laid down in the Clause 8(5) of NCTE Regulations, 2009, and therefore, the name of the said institution no more figures in the list of recognized institutions of M.Ed. course.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had filed W.P. No. 15445/2014 before the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Principal seat at Jabalpur. The Hon'ble High Court had passed an order dated 16.10.2014.

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid court order was placed before the WRC in its 212<sup>th</sup> meeting held on November 28-29, 2014 and the Committee decided that "...Vide NCTE Letter No. 49-3/2011/NCTE/N&S/ dated 13.07.2012, attention was invited towards the requirement of Accreditation from NAAC to those teacher training institutions who have been granted additional intake in B.Ed., B.P.Ed., & M.Ed. & M.P.Ed. courses. This letter was uploaded on the web-site of NCTE, Bhopal on [www.nctewrc.co.in](http://www.nctewrc.co.in).

The institution **NATIONAL B.Ed. COLLEGE, REWA** approached the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Principal Seat at Jabalpur. Vide their order dated 16.10.2014, the Hon'ble High Court have quashed, 'the impugned action', while giving liberty to the NCTE to proceed afresh in accordance with the law. **Hence, Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution u/s 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993."**

AND WHEREAS, show cause notice dated 22.12.2014 was issued under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, an opportunity was given to the institution as to why recognition/permission granted to the institution should not be withdrawn for violation of norms and standards of NCTE on the following grounds:

- As per Clause 8(5) of NCTE Regulation, 2009, "An institution that has been granted additional intake in Bachelor of Education and Bachelor of Physical Education teacher training courses after promulgation of the Regulations, 2005 i.e. the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 2006 shall have to get itself accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), with a Letter Grade B under the new grading system developed by NAAC, on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2011 failing which the additional intake granted shall stand withdrawn with effect from the academic session 2011-2012. Similarly, all institutions having a Master of Education and Master of Physical Education courses shall have to get NAAC Accreditation with at least a Letter Grade B on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2012, failing which Master of Education or Master of Physical Education Recognition granted to the institution shall stand withdrawn with effect from the academic session 2012-2013."

AND WHEREAS, the reply of Show cause notice has not been received, the matter placed before the WRC in its 288<sup>th</sup> meeting held on February 15-16, 2018. The Committee decided that "...Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.12.2014. Till date no reply has been received. The institution has also not submitted an affidavit to abide by the NCTE Regulations, 2014. **Hence, Recognition is withdrawn from the academic session 2018-2019."**

NOW THEREFORE, recognition granted to **NATIONAL B.Ed. COLLEGE, 7/68, CIVIL LINES, SIRMOUR CHOWK, REWA 486001, MADHYA PRADESH** for conducting M.Ed. course vide Recognition order dated 27.09.2006 is hereby withdrawn in terms of under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi - 110002 against the order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order.
