WITHDRAWAL ORDER

WHEREAS, WRC, NCTE had granted recognition/permission to, **Bab-E-Rehmat Educational Trust, St. Marys Convent Junior College, Khasra No. 05 B, Kausa, Mumbra, Thane, Maharashtra** vide order No. WRC/5-6/91/2006 dated 10.11.2006, For conducting the B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 seats.

And whereas, after the promulgation of NCTE (Recognition, Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 vide notification dt. 28.11.2014 the Bab-E-Rehmat Educational Trust, St. Marys Convent Junior College, Khasra No. 05 B, Kausa, Mumbra, Thane, Maharashtra offering B.Ed. course was informed via email/public notice to submit a duly notarized affidavit as an acceptance of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the institution.

And whereas, after the receipt of affidavit dt. 09.02.2015 from the institution, a revised recognition order no. WRC/APW02822/123367/MH/ (Revised order)2015/150568-575 dt. 12.08.2015 was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 seats (two basic units of 50 students) from session 2015-16.

And whereas, the WRC vide revised recognition order dt. 12.08.2015 had directed the institution to submit the followings documents in compliance of the NCTE Regulations, 2014:-

1. List of teaching staff, duly approved by the affiliating body, appointed by the institution for each course.
2. Proof of maintaining the Endowment fund and Reserve fund as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
3. A duly notarized building completion certificate (BCC) issued by the competent authority.

And whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its 255th meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice dt. 05.12.2016

And whereas, reply of show cause notice was not submitted by the institution and the matter placed before the WRC in its 285th meeting held on December 19th - 21th, 2017 and the Committee decided as follows :-

"The case file was seen. Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 05.12.2016. The institution has not replied so far.

Therefore, Recognition is withdrawn from the academic session 2018-2019."

Now, therefore, the recognition of Bab-E-Rehmat Educational Trust, St. Marys Convent Junior College, Khasra No. 05 B, Kausa, Mumbra, Thane, Maharashtra for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 seats (two basic units of 50 students), is hereby withdrawn from the academic session 2018-2019 in terms of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi - 110002 against the order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.
