RECOGNITION ORDER

Whereas, in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Shri Maharaja Agrasen Charitable Trust, Plot No. - 70 to 126/5, Shree Ramnath Bhimsen Marg, Samta Colony, Raipur, Chhattisgarh-492001 (WRCAPP3309) had submitted on 30.06.2015 the application to the Western Regional Committee of the NCTE for grant of recognition to Maharaja Agrasen International College, Plot no. - 70 to 126/5, Samta Colony, Raipur, Chhattisgarh - 492001 for D.El.Ed. Course.

And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

And whereas, on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit, and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee in its 271st meeting held on 23rd - 25th March, 2017 is satisfied that the institution/society fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the D.El.Ed. programme, such as, infrastructural and instructional facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, **the Western Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Maharaja Agrasen International College, Plot no. - 70 to 126/5, Samta Colony, Raipur, Chhattisgarh - 492001 for conducting D.El.Ed. programme of 2 (Two) years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2017-2018.**

The institution shall gradually move towards becoming a composite institution as per clause 8(1) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in term of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.

The recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, State Government etc. as applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with annual statement of accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall fill the GIS information on the NCTE website within one month from the date of this order.

The institution shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution:
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks
- e) in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- f) Fee charged from students;
- g) Available infrastructural facilities;
- h) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- i) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- j) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- k) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.
- l) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution contravenes the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
